



For an easy and secure installation

Required tools

- Sledgehammer
- 9/16 socket
- Level
- Floater to support standing dock's weight
- 2 to 4 people for transportation and installation

1 - Shore

For the starting point of your dock, you need to anchor the walkway to the shore. The angle you set with the two starting posts will determine the direction of the rest of the dock. Once set, drive the last posts and connect to the semi-floating section.

2 - Semi-floating walkway


Using our removable hinges, connect the platforms. Properly secure with cotter pin to prevent the hinge pin from moving.

3 - Floating dock

The largest section connects in the same way as the gangways using our removable hinges or welded with hinges and pins.

4 - Anchoring

This is where we attach the chain and concrete blocks to the chain plates to anchor the floating section in place. See our **blocks and chain installation guide** as reference.



Floaters

The chambers filled with high-density foam allow the docks to stay in the water during winter without any concerns. However, it is important to disconnect each section and release the chains. Secure them well to the shore for the winter season.
